Supporters help WHS annually serve more than 40,000 animals, including 5,000 wild animals. WHS receives no general government funding and operates thanks to the generosity of animal lovers like you!

As an independent nonprofit, WHS is not part of any national umbrella organization. As the largest shelter in the state of Wisconsin, WHS offers the following specialized services:

- A comprehensive adoption program that matches 13,000 homeless animals with new families; there are no time or space limits for any animals in our adoption program. We receive nearly all the area's surrendered animals, as well as animals from local and state animal control facilities, and animals transferred from other shelters. We are the stray animal holding facility for municipalities in Racine, Brown, Door, Kenosha, and Ozaukee Counties.
- Affordable spay/neuter services open to the public at the WHS Spay/Neuter Clinic in West Allis (9400 W. Lincoln Ave, West Allis, WI 53227).
- Outreach programming to serve families with pets in underserved areas.
- A foster program for animals in domestic violence situations.
- The Wildlife Rehabilitation Center, which provides rescue, rehabilitation, and release for 5,000 wild animals annually, at our Milwaukee Campus.
- A pet food bank to assist families with pets through tough financial times.
- Youth programs for children designed to engage and inspire the next generation of animal lovers!
- Dog training classes for dogs and puppies.
